I would like to introduce you to a children's book I recently published entitled Calvin Didn't Know.

Calvin Didn't Know addresses African-American History in a very engaging, non-combative, fun manner. As the reader becomes more involved in the story, he discovers interesting facts about day-to-day inventions of African-Americans. The book is designed as a reader for upper elementary and middle school students and includes biographical material, a list of patent information, and a short vocabulary section. Discussions with parents, students, and fellow educators reveal that Calvin Didn't Know addresses an arena where there is, unfortunately, a dearth of material. Outside of simple biographies and biographical material, there is precious little to be found.

I believe the story is a perfect fit for upper elementary and middle school programs. The design of the story is such that all youth will be enriched, however the information contained is particularly appropriate for African-American youth. As these youth are exposed to more and more achievements of those like themselves, their aspirations and consequently their possibilities expand. It is only through this expansion that we can truly give our youth the opportunities they so richly deserve.

In addition, a comprehensive, research based, reading unit plan has been developed for the book to allow seamless incorporation in to the classroom. The following pages include an overview of this unit plan as well as information regarding it's alignment to 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> grade TEKS, NCTE and IRA Reading Standards, and common reading strategies.
